MARKED ROUND – all distances are in meters, and there is no difference in distance based on gender.

To read this, find your Age Group, then Bow Type, and the numbers in that column will be the distances you will shoot. The left side shows the size of the target face for the distances in each box.

Yeoman archers who are precocious to compete may use the white peg, and take a number of steps toward the target as deemed suitable by the parent. Spectators are generally not a good idea on field archery courses unless special positions are designed by the Director of Shooting, for the sake of safety and the convenience of archers.
